# CAMP WAKANDA

The place where memories are made.

Camp Wakanda, owned and operated by the Allen Park Presbyterian Church, covers 160 acres in a wilderness setting near Lewiston, Michigan.

Camp Wakanda is a fully-licensed Children's Camp meeting or exceeding all rules, regulations, and standards set forth by the State of Michigan

El Lake is wholly contained within the camp and provides a sandy beach for swimming, and opportunities for boating and fishing. The camp has a large central dining room just a short walk from the lake. There are four dormitory-style buildings for campers to sleep in, a shower house divided for males and females and a lodge for large group functions. The buildings have a rustic look and are set among the pines throughout the property.

There is an infirmary cabin stocked with appropriate medical supplies. A camp health and safety person is in residence for all children's camps and a doctor in Lewiston is on call should the camp need a doctor. A water safety instructor (W.S.I.) is on the beach whenever children are in or near the water. A full time cook and a staff of teenage volunteers work in the kitchen and provide fun & friendly meals for the campers.

Camp life includes: Bible study, singing, swimming, organized sports, and various other outlets for the energy and creative expression of the campers.

Each camp staff includes one of our church staff, a Health Officer and a certified Water Safety Instructor.

Transportation to and from each camp is included in the cost of the camps.

## What you Need to Do to Go to Camp

Each camper attending Camp Wakanda must fill out the appropriate paperwork before attending camp. This includes the camp staff.

Appropriate paperworks:

- CHILD INFORMATION FORM
- CAMP WAKANDA HEALTH FORM
- MEDICAL EMERGENCY CARE AUTHORIZATION
- HEALTH HISTORY RECORD

This paperwork is available on our website and in the church office. This paperwork must be on hand in the church office before any camper can go to camp.
